On 09/22/2009 at about 1853 hours I, Sgt. Dietz, heard Officers Felbush and Mulholland get dispatched to a fight call in KU Parking Lot# 72, Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas. Dispatch advised at first there were around 8 people arguing in the parking lot. Dispatch later advised that there were 100 people in the parking lot and the altercation was now physical. I responded and pulled into the parking lot. As I pulled into the parking lot I saw several people wandering around the lot. I spoke with several subjects that had on KU Football t-shirts and they said that people had been fighting but they had left the area. All of the subjects that Officers Mulholland, Felbush, and I spoke with in the parking lot advised they were not apart of the fight and did not know what happened.

I spoke with the person who originally called in the fight and her name was [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was working in the Hawk Shop at the Burge Union. [REDACTED] advised that she heard yelling in the hallway and saw a bunch of people running through the hallway to get outside the building. [REDACTED] stated she believed that members from the KU basketball team were fighting with members from the KU Football team. [REDACTED] said there was a big mob of people outside the building and several people were fighting each other. [REDACTED] advised that after a few minutes, everyone vacated the area.

I was unable to find anyone who wanted to make a police report or pursue criminal charges in regards to the incident. Officer Felbush located a vehicle that had been damaged in the parking lot (case# U09-21393).

Incident Narrative

RO arrived at KU lot 72 on 9/22/09 at 1857 hours in reference to a fight call which apparently involved 30-40 people. Upon arrival with Sgt. Dietz and Officer Felbush there was no longer any fighting going on and most of the crowd had dispersed. RO spoke with a witness [REDACTED] who had seen some of the fighting. [REDACTED] stated that it appeared that members of the KU football team and the KU basketball team had been "baiting" each other and it had escalated into taunting and shouting and then fighting. [REDACTED] believe's that there were two major brawls and fights going on at the same time before the combatants heard the police sirens and fled the area. [REDACTED] could not identify any of the individuals who were actually fighting. RO was unable to locate any subjects at the scene who were involved or willing to be a victim.
